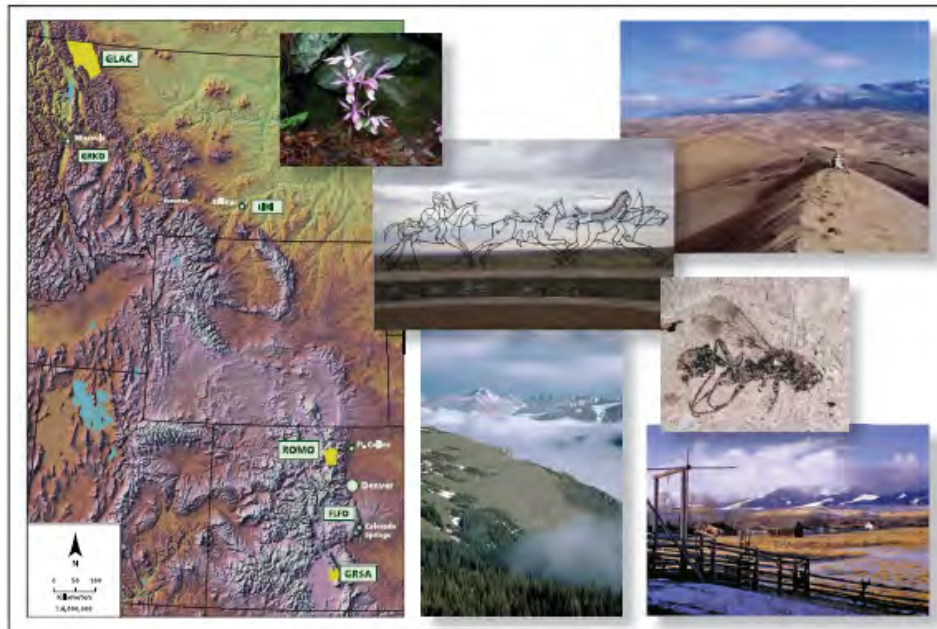
Job Announcement: **Ecologist/Crew Leader: GS-408-09** (this is a full-time TERM position not to exceed 13 months with possible extensions up to a total of 4 years)

Location: Fort Collins, CO but position requires extensive travel to national parks in Colorado and Montana during the summer and fall field seasons.

APPLY NOW (applications due on or before Feb. 22, 2008)

Incumbent conducts ecological monitoring fieldwork as crew leader in 6 park units in the Rocky Mountain Network. Vegetation and soils, streams and wetland monitoring protocols include plant and plant community identification and measurement, stream macroinvertebrate sampling and use of field ecological monitoring instruments (e.g., data loggers).

This is a field position from about June 1 – early October requiring travel to network parks. Extensive backcountry travel and camping will be common under a wide range of climate conditions. After the field season, you will work with the network team on data entry, processing and analysis and write-up in Fort Collins.
