# **Seasonal Botany Technician Position Available**

The Wildlife Resources Division, Wildlife Conservation Section (WCS) office in Social Circle announces a 40 hr/week botany field technician position available August 2022 – January 2023. The primary duty is rare plant and vegetation monitoring throughout Georgia especially in the coastal plain and sandhills region, followed by a wide range of opportunities in applied conservation and restoration work. Must be comfortable working independently and as part of a team. The position is based out of our Social Circle office, 45 minutes from Athens and Atlanta. Housing or carpooling options are available. Travel is statewide with overnight stays; transportation and field lodging are provided. Field workdays can be >10 hrs. in physically challenging conditions. Start date is August 15th. Salary is \$13.00 / hr.

## **Job Responsibilities**

<u>Primary:</u> 1. Assistance to Wildlife Biologists and Technicians with vegetation sampling and photo monitoring of habitat restoration. 2. Rare plant or habitat restoration activities in the field <u>Secondary:</u> 3. Plant identification. 4. Maintenance and organization of field tools and equipment.

### **Preferred Qualifications**

Candidates with at least one of the following skills will be preferred for the position:

- 1) Experience with basic vegetation sampling tools and methods, and with plant identification
- 2) Experience with hot and humid fieldwork conditions, GPS, and off-road 4-wheel drive vehicles
- 3) Experience with organizing and maintaining field equipment
